Cybersecurity: The Dance of Privacy and Peril



Cigaritis meghamalaiensis stands out with its distinctive conjoined discal and post-discal bands on the forewing's underside, setting it apart from its counterparts in Peninsular India and Sri Lanka. With this addition, the Western Ghats now boast 337 butterfly species, with 40 being exclusive to the region, showcasing its ecological richness.

This discovery underscores the importance of biodiversity conservation, emphasizing the need to protect these unique species, akin to safeguarding priceless artifacts in a museum. It serves as a call to preserve nature's beautiful tapestry for future generations.

Rothschild's Slipper Orchid: Nature's Rarity

Taste the Flavors of Punjab


